 - This performance-based restricted stock unit (PSU) award was granted to the Reporting Person on March 3, 2015 and vested on April 2, 2018, as determined by the Compensation Committee of the Board of Directors. The payout of shares of Class A Common Stock
- (1) pursuant to the PSU award was determined based on the Issuer's earnings per share (EPS) of \$9.14, return on equity (ROE) of 25% and individual effectiveness of the Reporting Person for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017, as measured against the target performance goals set by the Compensation Committee at the time of grant. The payout percentages for the PSU award based on target achievement was 120% for EPS and 92.43% for ROE.
- (2) The reported amount consists of 3,057 restricted stock units and 8,125 shares of Class A Common Stock. The restricted stock units are to be settled in an equal number of shares of Class A Common Stock upon vesting.
- (3) These shares of Class A Common Stock were sold pursuant to a 10b5-1 plan.
- The price reported is the weighted average price of multiple transactions ranging from \$22.25 to \$22.50. The reporting person hereby undertakes to provide upon request to the SEC, the Issuer or a security holder of the Issuer the number of Class A Common Stock and the prices at which the transactions were effected.
- (5) The reported amount consists of 3,057 restricted stock units and 6,828 shares of Class A Common Stock. The restricted stock units are to be settled in an equal number of shares of Class A Common Stock upon vesting.
- Pursuant to the terms of an exchange agreement, Class A Units of Private National Mortgage Acceptance Company, LLC are exchangeable for shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer on a one-for-one basis, subject to customary conversion rate adjustments.
- (7) This nonstatutory stock option to purchase 2,018 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer will vest as to one-third of the optioned shares on each of June 13, 2014, 2015 and 2016, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service through each date.
- (8) This nonstatutory stock option to purchase 3,077 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer will vest as to one-third of the optioned shares on each of February 26, 2015, 2016 and 2017, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service through each date.
- (9) This nonstatutory stock option to purchase 3,032 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer will vest as to one-third of the optioned shares on each of March 3, 2016, 2017 and 2018, subject to the Reporting Person's committed service through each date.
- (10) This nonstatutory stock option to purchase 3,530 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer will vest as to one-third of the optioned shares on each of March 7, 2017, 2018 and 2019, subject to the Reporting Person's committed service through each date.
- (11) This nonstatutory stock option to purchase 2,943 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer will vest as to one-third of the optioned shares on each of March 6, 2018, 2019 and 2020, subject to the Reporting Person's committed service through each date.
