The Reporting Person is a managing director of Goldman, Sachs & Co. ("Goldman Sachs"). Goldman Sachs is a wholly-owned subsidiary of The Goldman Sachs Group, Inc. ("GS Group"). The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership of the securities

Pursuant to an underwriting agreement, dated November 6, 2013 (the "Underwriting Agreement"), and in connection with the registered public offering (the "Offering") of shares of common stock, par value \$0.01 per share (the "Common Stock"), of MRC Global Inc. (the "Company"), pursuant to the prospectus supplement to the prospectus filed by the Company on November 8, 2013 (the "Prospectus

- (2) Supplement"), which offering was consummated on November 13, 2013, GS Capital Partners V Fund, L.P., GS Capital Partners V GmbH & Co. KG, GS Capital Partners V Institutional, L.P., GS Capital Partners V Offshore Fund, L.P., GS Capital Partners VI Fund, L.P., GS Capital Partners VI GmbH & Co. KG, GS Capital Partners VI Offshore Fund, L.P. and GS Capital Partners VI Parallel, L.P. (collectively, the "Funds") (continued in footnote 3)

sold 17,489,233 shares of Common Stock. The public offering price in the Offering of Common Stock was \$28.90 per share of Common Stock and the underwriting discount was \$0.40 per share of Common Stock. Accordingly, the Funds sold an aggregate of 17,489,233 shares of Common Stock and received a price per share of \$28.50 (which is net of underwriting discounts and commissions) for an aggregate amount of \$498,443,140.50.

Crampton and Daly, each a managing director of Goldman Sachs, each has an understanding with GS Group pursuant to which he holds such securities for the benefit of GS Group. In addition, an additional 6,049 shares are beneficially owned directly by Goldman Sachs and indirectly by GS Group. Goldman Sachs holds an open short position of 48 shares of Common Stock, due to an exempt transaction.
