- (1) 401(k) Plan: This amount includes shares and dividends acquired during the fiscal year pursuant to the H.B. Fuller Company Thrift Plan.
2000 Stock Incentive Plan: Amount includes 9,423 restricted shares that were awarded pursuant to H.B. Fuller Company's 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: 893 restricted shares vest in two equal annual installments beginning April 15, 2007; 4,474 restricted shares vest effective December 2, 2007; and 4,056 restricted shares vest effective December 1, 2008. Total amount also includes restricted shares acquired pursuant to a dividend accrual feature of the 2000 Stock Incentive Plan.
- (2) Amended and Restated 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: Amount includes 2,499 restricted shares that were awarded pursuant to H.B. Fuller Company's Amended and Restated 2000 Stock Incentive Plan and will vest effective December 4, 2009. Amount also includes restricted shares acquired pursuant to a dividend accrual feature of the Amended and Restated 2000 Stock Incentive Plan.
- (3) 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option vests four in equal annual installments beginning on January 17, 2003.
- (4) 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option vests in four equal annual installments beginning on December 9, 2003.
- (5) Deferred Compensation Plan: These units convert into shares of common stock on a 1-for-1 basis.
