(1) These Ordinary Shares were sold in multiple transactions at sales prices ranging from \$50.6214 to \$50.6600, inclusive. (4) Options granted to the Reporting Person under the Seagate Technology plc 2012 Equity Incentive Plan (the "Plan") are subject to a four year vesting schedule. One quarter of the options vested September 10, 2013. The remaining options vest in equal monthly installments over the 36 months following September 10, 2013.
