Pursuant to the Support Agreement, dated April 10, 2008, among The First American Corporation (the Company), Highfields Capital Management LP, Highfields GP LLC, Highfields Associates LLC, Highfields Capital I L.P., Highfields Capital II L.P., and Highfields Capital III L.P. (the Support Agreement), on August 25, 2009, Matthew B. Botein was appointed to the Board of Directors of the Company to fill the vacancy created by the recent retirement of Patrick F. Stone. The Support Agreement is discussed in further detail in the Company's Current Report on Form 8-K dated April 10, 2008. As required by the Support Agreement, Mr. Botein will serve on the Executive Committee of the Board. A copy of the press release announcing the appointment is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1.

In addition, on August 25, 2009, the Company's Compensation Committee revised the relocation arrangement with Anthony S. Pizsel, chief financial officer and treasurer, to increase the reimbursable expense amount by \$100,000 and allow for reimbursements to be made until the entire amount has been fully utilized. The category of reimbursable expenses was modified to include expenses associated with residences from which he relocated in connection with the commencement of his employment with the Company. In the event Mr. Pizsel voluntarily resigns on or prior to the earlier of June 30, 2010 and the date on which the spin-off transaction announced by the Company in January 2008 is consummated, the Company will be entitled to recover any utilized portion of the \$100,000 increase in the relocation expense allowance.
