On May 10, 2017, Dermira, Inc. ( *Dermira* ) issued a press release announcing the pricing of its offering of \$250,000,000 aggregate principal amount of 3.00% Convertible Senior Notes due 2022 (the *Notes* ) to qualified institutional buyers pursuant to Rule 144A under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended. Dermira also granted the initial purchasers of the Notes a 30-day over-allotment option to purchase up to an additional \$37,500,000 aggregate principal amount of Notes. A copy of the press release announcing the pricing of the Convertible Senior Notes is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and is incorporated herein by reference.
