- Effective immediately after the spin-off on June 30, 2011, of Marathon Petroleum Corporation ("MPC") by Marathon Oil Corporation ("MRO"), the reporting person ceased to be a director of Marathon Oil Corporation and became a director of Marathon Petroleum Corporation. In connection with the spin-off, MRO director restricted stock unit awards of nonemployee directors who became directors of MPC immediately after the spin-off were replaced with substitute MPC director restricted stock unit awards, each of which generally preserve the value of the original awards.
