- (1) Restricted stock units ("RSUs") convert into Common Stock on a one-for-one basis.
- (2) The reported shares were withheld to cover the reporting person's tax liability in connection with the vesting of RSUs. These shares were not issued to or sold by the reporting person.
- (3) On February 3, 2016, the reporting person was granted 10,000 RSUs, vesting in three equal installments beginning on the first market trading day following the first anniversary of the grant date.
- (4) Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one (1) share of Issuer's common stock.

The shares subject to this option shall vest at a rate of 1/48th of the total number of shares vest on the one-month anniversary of February 6, 2017 (the "Option Vesting Commencement Date") and 1/48th of the total number of shares each monthly anniversary of the Option

- (6) Vesting Commencement Date thereafter (and if there is no corresponding day, on the last day of the month) for so long as the recipient of the option remains a "Service Provider" (as defined in the 2013 Plan) of the Company, such that the total number of shares shall be fully vested on the four-year anniversary of the Option Vesting Commencement Date.
